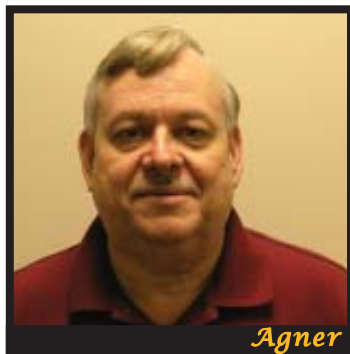


# FSU Credit Union Nominating Committee Presents Slate of Candidates for 2007

Florida State University Credit Union's Nominating Committee, consisting of Valerie Beynon, Chair, Carolyn Shackelford and Dr. Stacy Sirmans reviewed a list of qualified candidates and officially nominates four candidates to fill two open positions on the Board of Directors. William Agner, Frank Bowden, Jr., Rustam Khoudaiberdiev and Mark Striffler are the candidates up for election. The two candidates selected by vote will serve one 3-year term each. All positions are unpaid volunteers and their bios are listed below.



## **William S. Agner, Director (Incumbent)**

William "Bill" Agner has served on the FSU Credit Union Board for 15 years and been a member of the Credit Union since 1975. During his tenure he served as Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer and chaired several board committees and worked on one league committee. Bill holds the Frederick W. Raiffensen Award for participation in the Volunteer Achievement Program. He has worked at FSU for over 32 years and is currently assigned to the ERP Office. Bill and his wife Sherry have one married son.



## **Frank L. Bowden Jr., Director**

Frank Bowden joined the FSU Credit Union in 1996 and has been a resident of Tallahassee since 1984. He is currently employed as the Director of Information Technologies at Booth Companies. Frank began his career in 1989 working at the FSU College of Law and has extensive experience in the field of information technologies. In addition to his full time employment with Booth Companies, Frank also manages his own Small Business which has been in operation since 1996. He is Past Master of J. Edwin Larson Lodge 361 and is also a member of the Marzuq Shrine Temple. Frank belonged to various civic organizations while living in Blountstown while growing up, and would like to have the opportunity to do so again by serving on the Board of Directors for FSU Credit Union.



## **Rustam Khoudaiberdiev, Director**

*In accordance with the credit union bylaws, any member may place their name into nomination by petition for the two open board positions. The petition may be obtained by contacting the Secretary of the Board at P.O. Box 182499 Tallahassee, FL 32318-0022. The petition must have the signature of at least 50 credit union members and must be received by the secretary at least 45 days prior to the annual meeting which is scheduled for Thursday, April 19, 2007. In the event no petitions are received, there will be no balloting for the positions for which only one candidate has been selected and the chair shall declare the nominees duly elected at the annual meeting.*
